Parents Night Out | Saturday, April 20 | 6 - 10pm

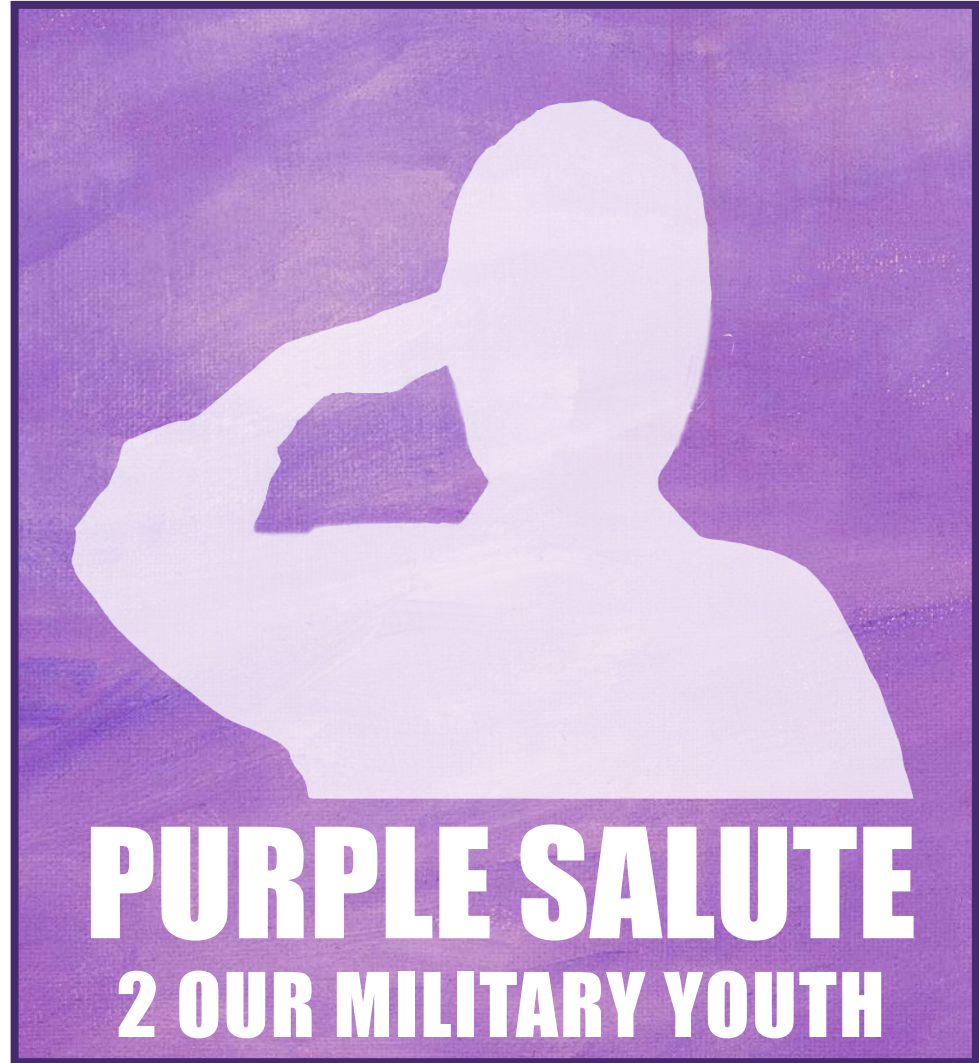
PYC is giving parents a break on Saturday! While parents relax, youth will be having FuN playing lazer tag & eating pizza at Prairies Youth Center.
